THE NEW WORLD ORDER AND THE CECIL RHODES SCHOLARSHIPS

Is the Rhodes Scholarship Program, i.e., sending 32 of America's brightest youth, annually to Oxford, England, solely for a superior education?

Or - is the goal, (as envisioned by the late Cecil Rhodes), to establish a worldwide group of elitists; dedicated to a plan - and to join with others of like mind, for the purpose of directing the civilization of the future - in accordance with the aspect and aims of their stewardship?

Cecil Rhodes - the benefactor of this scholarship program entered his aspirations for the future in two manuscripts; written in 1877, entitled: "CONFESSION OF FAITH"..... "The idea gleaming and dancing before ones eyes like a will-of-the-wisp at last frames itself into a plan. Why should we not form a secret society with but one object the furtherance of the British Empire and the bringing of the whole uncivilized world under British rule for the recovery of the United States for the making of the Anglo-Saxon race but one Empire. What a dream, but yet it is probable, it is possible. ... The society should inspire and even own portions of the press for the press rules the mind of the people."

The vision - the goal of Cecil Rhodes is adhered to by the Rhodes Trustees. Carlton Kemp Allen, Rhodes Scholar and Warden of Rhodes House 1931-1952, wrote in his book: FORTY YEARS OF RHODES SCHOLARSHIP; 1944: (P. 18) "The Rhodes Trustees will not be satisfied until a Rhodes Scholar is President of the United States"...

Frank Aydelotte, then American Secretary to the Rhodes Trustees wrote a book entitled: THE AMERICAN RHODES SCHOLARSHIPS; A REVIEW OF THE FIRST FORTY YEARS, 1946. On P. 99, he mentions: "In Washington, more Rhodes Scholars have been attracted to the State Department than to any other Branch of the Government, but there is good representation in the Departments of War, Navy, Justice..."

A Washington D.C., 'Times Herald' article of 10/11/43; (P. 2) headlined: Rhodes Scholars find havens in New Deal Press, Radio; 'Bright Boys' return from Oxford to Urge Stronger U.S. - British Ties.

And the Chicago Daily Tribune, (July 15 through 31, 1951) researched and printed a comprehensive series of articles on the involvement, and influence of the American Rhodes Scholars in Government, Academia and the Press.

After reviewing the events herein described, one can discern the Cecil Rhodes Plan - its continuity, and current maturation. The esprit de corps of the Rhodes group came to the fore during the recent election campaign, when Presidential aspirant Clinton was under heavy attack from the Bush Administration.

A Wall Street Journal article of 3/12/92, described how 'Outsider' Clinton received Insider help.
